Common Name : Asia Belle

Scientific Name : *Radermachera sinica*

also known as : Asian Belle

mature unpruned height : 8 mtrs

mature unpruned width : 6 mtrs

pruned height : from 2 mtrs

foliage : lime green

new growth : pale green

flower colour : white

perfume : slight

flower season : early summer

cold/frost tolerance : ok when established, grown happily in Picton

pots and planters : ok but will stretch quickly if left unpruned

hates : wet feet, not being pruned

loves : sun or shade

Growers Notes : This plant grows fast!! Great for a city backyard to screen out neighbourhood development or to throw a bit of comfortable shade. Foliage is blemish free and is very tough except in wet, poor draining soils. Can be kept pruned but has a naturally beautiful shape without training.
